WHEREAS the and GFSU (hereinafter jointly referred to as "the Parties" and individually as "the Party") wish to enter into this MoU for the purposes of establishing strategic academic and training co-operation in Forensic & Investigative sciences.

NOW THEREFORE the Parties hereby agree as follows:

Training purposes;

ARTICLE 1

SCOPE AND FIELDS OF STRATEGIC CO-OPERATION

- 1.1 The Parties hereby agree to implement within the framework of the rules and regulations applicable to each of the Parties and subject to availability of funds of nd resources, the following programmes and activities which may include, but are not limited to:
 - 1.1 Assistance by GFSU in setting up different laboratories, for example, Cyber Security Laboratory, Digital Forensic Laboratory, Forensic Sciences Laboratory etc. and upgrading existing Laboratories for _______ in Egypt;

ARTICLE 2 FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENTS

The specific financial arrangements for academic programmes, training programmes any other related programmes and services shall be discussed and decided by reconsent as and when required by the Parties to this MoU.



ARTICLE 3 INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

- The Parties agree that any intellectual property rights arising from or in connection with any programme or activity under this MoU, through and by the joint and collaborative efforts of the Parties shall be jointly owned and subject to any-other terms and conditions as may be agreed upon in writing.
- 3.2 The Parties shall acknowledge one another in any form of writing, publication of presentation based on research derived from the co-operative efforts of the Parties under this MoU, unless otherwise mutually agreed upon in writing.

ARTICLE 4 CONFIDENTIALITY

The Parties agree and undertake to keep confidential at all times any information of data that may be exchanged, acquired or shared in connection with any programme or activity conducted pursuant to this MoU save where the same is already in public the domain.

ARTICLE 5 ENTRY INTO FORCE AND DURATION

This Mcu shall enter into force on the date of the last signature and shall be valid for period of three (3) years from the date of signature by the Parties and may be extende for such further periods as may be agreed by the Parties in writing.

ARTICLE 6 TERMINATION

- 6.1 This MoU may be terminated at any time by mutual agreement between the frarties or by any Party giving the other written notice of not less than three (months of its intention to terminate this MoU.
- At the termination of this MoU, the provisions of any other separate agreement entered into pursuant to this MoU shall continue to govern any unexpire obligations commenced or assumed hereunder until they are fully executed.



ARTICLE 7 MISCELLANEOUS

The Parties acknowledge that all visits or exchange of staff, students or administrate shall be subject to compliance with the entry and visa regulations of the Partie respective countries.

ARTICLE 8 NON-BINDING NATURE OF THE MOU

- This MoU is not intended to be legally binding. It merely expresses the intentic and understanding of the Parties which shall form the basis of any legally bindi agreement(s) to be drafted and executed in the future.
 - 8.2 The Parties hereby agree that they are not bound exclusively by this MoU and shad at liberty to enter into any separate agreements or arrangements with any the party without reference to the other Party.

ARTICLE 9 FORCE MAJEURE

- In the event of the occurrence of an event of force majeure which shall include the host be limited to the following; riots, floods, acts of God, natural disasters a wars, neither Party shall be held accountable for the problems and costs arisi from the failure to fulfil obligations under this MoU.
- In the event that the force majeure subsists for a period of six (6) months, the Pa experiencing such event shall give fourteen (14) days written notice to the oth Party, where upon this MoU shall automatically terminate due to superveni impossibility of performance.

ARTICLE 10 APPLICABLE LAW

The MeU shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the Indic

ARTICLE 11 DISPUTE(S) RESOLUTION

The Pairies seek to resolve amicably in good faith any dispute(s) that may arise in respect of any matter connected to this MoU.
